### GARDEN CLUB

Just in time for Easter & Spring – Easter Centerpiece class on Sunday, March 20th at 2 pm in the Clubhouse. Member John Drohan will be showing attendees how to make a lovely live flower arrangement suitable for an Easter table arrangement. Be sure to sign up early as John's December class brought many accolades by those who attended as well as many regrets from others who missed the class. Please see our flier for more information.

Many thanks to member Judy Beam and Master Gardner Paula Youngs for their informative presentation, "Gearing up for Spring" on Thursday, February 11th. Judy and Paula instructed the 12 attendees on how, when and what to prune as well as which tools were right for the job. Attendees were given hand-outs on garden equipment and garden do's and don'ts. Get a soil test prior to planting. Purchase the best tools you can afford. Always carry pruners in your pocket when you go in the garden. Do not prune crepe myrtle – it's called "crepe murder." In addition, one of the attendees reported that there is a free app for smart phones- "Like That - gardening" which identifies plants from photos taken on the phones.

Spring is just around the corner and so are garden pests such as aphids. Now is the time to control them before they cause damage in the garden. ## PROPERTY COMMITTEE - WHAT TIME IS IT ??

It is time for homeowners wishing to take responsibility of maintaining the common areas adjoining their deeded property to contact their Phase Representative for the MTHOA/HOMEOWNER AGREEMENT form. He or she will provide you with a copy of the form and will review the guidelines with you. Each application is subject to Board approval. Completed applications must be received by the Property Committee Chairperson, Leo Reger, by Thursday, March 31, 2016. Late applications will not be accepted. Likewise, any homeowner who currently has a MTHOA/Homeowner Agreement and wishes have it discontinued must write a letter and submit it to the Property Chairperson. Again, your request will be reviewed and acted on by the Board of Directors and you will be notified of their decision. The same deadline date applies.

It is time for the Clubhouse floors to be “revitalized”, in other words a deep cleaning. This cleaning involves a three step process and requires the floor to be not walked on for 24 hour periods. The floor will be done in sections; therefore the Clubhouse will be *closed from Thursday, March 10th through Sunday, March 13th*. We will reopen it on Monday, March 14th.

It is time to officially recognize the new Chairperson for the Property Committee, Leo Reger. Leo has been an active member of the Property Committee for a number of years and has served as the Representative for Phase 7 and as one of the “gate” people.
