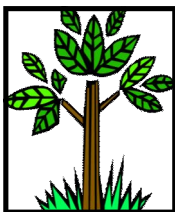

Spring has sprung and Myrtle Trace is in full bloom. We have been treated to profuse blooms of Flowering Quince, Flowering Pears, Ornamental Cherries, Swamp Maples, Forsythia, Camellias, Azaleas and Daffodils. The show continues this month with the arrival of several more varieties of Daffodils, late blooming Gumpo Azaleas, Loropetalums and the sweet-smelling Tea Olive.

Many thanks to the Garden Club members who have been working to clean debris; clipping old growth; transplanting and performing other necessary garden duties at the Clubhouse gardens. Please take special notice of the area and enjoy the beautiful blooms that are on display at this time of year.

Of course this is also a time to head out into our gardens to trim back any cold-injured plants to ensure healthy unimpeded new growth. But don't be tempted to remove the Daffodil foliage after the flowers have faded. The leaves need time to nourish the bulb for next year's flowers. Leave them alone for 12 weeks after flowering or until foliage flops over and yellows. You may plant annuals between the bulb foliage.

We wish to thank resident John Drohan for conducting the Easter Flower Arrangement class on March 20th. As of publication date, twenty participants were registered.

# Common Ground Sod Replacement Request Form 2016

To be eligible for sod replacement you-

- \* Must be the homeowner
- \* Must have a working sprinkler system

If your request for sod replacement is approved you are responsible for keeping the new sod thoroughly watered for at least ten days. Normal watering shall be resumed after that time.

You will **NOT** be eligible for sod replacement if you have signed a Common Ground Maintenance Agreement.

### Policy On Pets and Feeding and/or Sheltering of Stray/Feral Cats:

When off the owner's property, all pets including cats must be leashed. Renters, and/or guests, who have pets, must abide by these guidelines. When walking pets in any common or deeded area in Myrtle Trace, it is the walker's responsibility for picking up the pet's droppings. If an unleashed dog or cat whose ownership is known is observed on common areas or on private property other than that of the pet's owner, or there is evidence of a resident feeding and/or sheltering stray/feral cats, the complaining resident must submit a signed, WRITTEN letter of complaint to the Board.

The offending resident will be personally notified of the complaint. If offense reoccurs, the resident will be notified in writing and any further violations after the verbal/personal notification and written notification will result in a fine of \$25.00.

Any resident who receives a notice of a violation, but believes none has occurred, may appeal to the Board of Directors in writing. The Board shall rule on the violation within 30 days and notify the resident in writing of its decision. Payment of fines shall be due on the 1st day of the month following the decision by the Board. Effective March 16, 2016.

### Policy on the Feeding of Waterfowl and Wild Animals:

Horry County ordinance prohibits the feeding or providing of food for domestic or migratory waterfowl in residential areas of Horry County. This prohibition also applies to wild animals that traverse our community that may include raccoon, fox, coyote and opossum, among others. The prohibition states further "no person shall create or foster any condition, or allow any condition to exist or continue, which results in a congregation or congestion of domestic or migratory waterfowl in residential areas of Horry County." The Horry County Police Dept. is authorized and directed to enforce this ordinance. In order to comply with this policy, MTHOA also prohibits the feeding or providing of food for domestic or migratory waterfowl and wild animals in all areas of Myrtle Trace. Effective March 16, 2016.
